This privacy statement outlines the policies and practices for the Best Case Bankruptcy product web sites of CCH Incorporated ("CCH"). This Internet Privacy Policy contains information about the gathering and dissemination practices for www.bestcase.com and www.mycaseinfo.com.

Collection of Personal Information from Site Visitors

CCH may collect and/or track (1) the home server domain names, e-mail addresses, type of client computer, and type of Web browser of visitors to Best Case Bankruptcy product Web sites, (2) the e-mail addresses of visitors that communicate with CCH via e-mail, (3) information knowingly provided by the visitor in online forms, registration forms, surveys, and contest entries (including demographic and personal profile data), and (4) aggregate and user-specific information on which pages visitors access.

CCH may place Internet "cookies" on visitors' hard drives.
